Dear Water Orton Parish Council Clerk

Work is beginning on a review of Warwickshire County Council's Rights of Way Improvement Plan (ROWIP). Warwickshire County Council is seeking the views of your council prior to drafting the new ROWIP so that the document reflects local priorities.

Warwickshire County Council is responsible for around 1700 miles of public footpaths, bridleways, restricted byways and byways open to all traffic across the whole of Warwickshire County.

Warwickshire County Council's ROWIP is an important strategic policy document, which the council is required by law to have in place. It sets out how Warwickshire County Council can make sure the public rights of way network meets the needs of the public, now and in the future. The process of reviewing the ROWIP, and the engagement being carried out before the new ROWIP is drafted, will help the council to better understand the needs of Warwickshire County residents.

Warwickshire County Council would like the views of Water Orton Parish Council. Please find attached a letter from Marion Borman, Warwickshire County Council's Rights of Way Team Leader, inviting the views of your council.
