Councillor Freeman had asked for (1) the patch of land outside the park/playing field entrance to be flattened to better facilitate access from those less able bodied/ pushchair users to prevent an accident from occurring, and (2) for the patch of land to be designated as a <u>no parking area</u> so that those who are less able bodied/using pushchairs are not forced into Vicarage Lane to access the entrance, moving into the path of vehicular traffic which resents a risk.
