The club is seeking to explore options for a third court (Without floodlighting) and has previously received tacit support from councillors and officers. Initial consultation has been undertaken with local residents.</p> <p>Full plans have not been developed but it is hoped that Parish Council would give initial support to enable the development of detailed plans to be considered.</p>
