Just to confirm on our call last night:

I have secured a new defibrillator with a cabinet lock box courtesy of the Football Foundation and the Premier League. This is free and the football club have not been charged for any of this equipment.

As a club, we are donating this for public use with the intention this is installed on the Pavilion wall.

I can get to do the installation and I will pay him a nominal fee for his time. It makes more sense this being on the Pavilion rather than the Bowling Club building as that is not as easy to access if required in an emergency.

There is a 7 year warranty as standard and as soon as I register it this will be increased to 10 years which covers the battery pack.

The pads have an expiry date of January 2027 so they would need to be replaced then.

I appreciate I didn't raise this yesterday but in lieu of the donation of this kit by the football club, would the council consider a token reduction on the rent for the pitch and changing facilities for the next 12 months?
